With India's Digital Personal Data Protection (DPDP) Rules, 2025 in force, organisations have entered a critical transition period. The compliance clock is ticking, with the next major milestone arriving in November 2026, when the framework relating to Consent Managers becomes operational. Thereafter, the core compliance obligations for Data Fiduciaries are scheduled to become enforceable from May 2027, leaving organisations with a limited window to establish governance frameworks, redesign data management practices, implement consent mechanisms, strengthen cybersecurity controls, and prepare for regulatory oversight.

Against this backdrop, and to help organisations navigate this evolving landscape, the Corporate Affairs Committee of PHDCCI is organising a **Seminar on DPDP COMPLIANCE: FROM POLICY TO PRACTICE** - on **Friday, 21 August 2026 from 2.00 PM – 6.00 PM at PHD House, 4/2, Siri Institutional Area, August Kranti Marg, New Delhi – 110016**. *The Session would be followed by High Tea.*
